Chapter 4 - Light Beings

The Council:

“Light beings” really is a term of man, but it is to indicate a soul or an entity who has grown in the awareness of godly action so they become a beacon in the creation for others. Those who have reached the attitude or the consciousness of what we might call a light being have learned the essence of love. They have learned how to fulfill themselves as they were intended to fulfill. It is the absolute attitude of love. With that attitude there is an unending desire to help others feel fulfilled, to experience fulfillment, to become aware of fulfillment, and so one's complete existence is in the manifesting of avenues, attitudes, and experiences where others may share in that fulfillment. The ultimate work in the Celestial Level is to rid yourself of self-love and fill that emptiness with God-love or godly love, to learn how to love yourself totally for what you really are.

Celestial beings have an unending desire to help others. They have such a beautiful feeling of peace and fulfillment that they wish the same for everyone. Seeing others fulfilled has become their passion. All of us have interests, passions, and some of us even become fanatics about some aspects of life. There are people who love gardening. Others are fanatical about sports and there are many who enjoy teaching others. Children want to be firemen, doctors, baseball players. As they grow they tend to become more realistic. They mature and their interests change. So it is with souls in the God-Made Heavenly Realm. They mature to the point where they develop a complete understanding of the spiritual aspects of life. They have a passion for spiritual growth. Once they taste the joy that helping others can bring and experience the wonders of a renewed spiritual awareness, they want to share it.

When you first hear a song that you like, you immediately want to share your discovery with your friends. It is the same with spiritual growth. There is a strong desire to share.

Light beings have grown in awareness to the point where they naturally manifest a godly type of love. They understand their position in the Divine Plan and willingly accept it. They perform selfless acts of love and are further filled with love. These souls are totally consumed with the desire to see others fulfilled as they are. Their actions become a living beacon for those who are striving to achieve what they have achieved.

If we are willing to place our needs second, then we are serving the Divine because it is His wish that we demonstrate our godliness and our right to a place in His Heavenly Realm through serving our fellow man. When we can do that, we are actually serving ourselves because it is also the desire of our higher self that we act in that manner. Service is the first priority of the higher self. It is not, however, the first priority of the conscious self, the material self, but it must be our goal to change our priorities to a spiritual order of existence. By changing our priorities, we are preparing ourselves for the God-Made Heavenly Realm.

Our soul has complete knowledge of its original state of existence and will do whatever it deems necessary to keep itself on the path back to its origin. The question might be asked, "If that is so, then why have not all souls returned to their original state long ago?" The answer is that the all-knowing soul must work through many, many layers of consciousness, many layers of belief formed by rationalization of the ego through countless lifetimes. Our self-serving egos place rationalizations between the soul and the conscious mind so that the consciousness will not scrutinize its motivations too closely.

The soul tries to do what is best, but it can only accomplish what it desires to the degree that it receives cooperation from our conscious mind and the other levels of consciousness. Past experiences and habits that we have formed, and the degree that society has influenced us, challenge the soul to accomplish all that it desires. Earlier we termed these interferences as our personal affections and intentions. What this means is that a concept that started at a soul level to be a joyous, godly experience ends up manifesting as something far less than what it was intended to be. All problems that we face in life, if viewed clearly from a spiritual perspective, can be laid directly at the doorstep of man himself. The Council said it very concisely, "Mankind has deemed the material existence to be a hard taskmaster to itself."

This is not the wish of our Creator or our soul. All of us at SOL hope that this publication on Life After Death will give everyone knowledge that they can use to help eliminate fear and misunderstanding and speed all of us through the God-Made Heavenly Realm.

In The Council's closing message they remind us that the path to a heavenly existence is not narrow or difficult. Nor is it filled with rituals and mysticism. It is not a path that only the elite or the mighty can follow. It is for all. There are many roads leading to the House of the Divine. Each of us must follow our own path while nourishing ourselves on Divine Wisdom and Guidance.
