AN INTRODUCTION TO THE COUNCIL

The Council has often referred to themselves as "spiritual beings." We must remember that this is a very elusive term and means something far greater than what we normally have been taught to understand as "spiritual beings."

In our finite minds we look upon spiritual beings as living beings confined in similar manners as we in the physical, and this is not the case with some levels beyond the physical. But in this expanded description from The Council, we begin to realize that there are levels that we can reach as spiritual beings that far surpass our present concepts.

Respectfully, I submit The Council's own personal description of themselves.

THE COUNCIL SPEAKS OF THEMSELVES

After a soul or an entity has accomplished a certain level or degree of perfection, through whatever system that is the ruling belief system of that time, then the individual or the soul or the entity is elevated to a level wherein it is not necessary for reincarnation. Once entering the spiritual realms without the need to reincarnate, a growth period is undergone. Many steps of awareness or many levels of awareness are accomplished, many degrees of elevation, many degrees of perfection until finally the soul, the entity has evolved into a state where there are no levels, no degrees, but begins to expand in love and awareness to the point where there is a total mergence or merging with other beings; where all ideas of limitations, all awarenesses of false limitations, have been done away with; where the person or the soul or the entity begins to realize its true unlimitedness and in that begins to expand greater and greater and greater, interweaving more delicately and more closely with all others and all other things, and in so doing grows closer to the Divine Himself. Once a soul or entity has reached this level, then they are in union with others, total union, yet completely individual, and yet completely united. This soul, this entity has its own personality, yet delicately flows in and out and with other souls but yet maintains its own personality, its own being. The soul, the entity becomes more god-like in that it becomes part of all things, yet maintains its own personality, its own being. Once a soul has reached this level then there is no name, there is no body as you would recognize or understand, but a more complete and unlimited **Child of God**, one who is so developed that no name could ever describe him. That is the existence we live in, and if you wish to use confining and restricting terminologies as levels, then we souls have to say that is the level we exist in. In all of mankind's history this level has never before spoken in the **physical plane**.

Even though we refer to ourselves as "spiritual beings," we use such statements only to give all who come to us some idea to relate to or some concept that they can relate to.

THE TRANCE PHENOMENON

We believe The Trances of William Allen LePar are the rarest paranormal experiences known to modern man. The only example of a similar phenomenon ended with the death of [Edgar Cayce](#) in 1945. The Council's unparalleled revelations, through Mr. LePar's trances, are made available to the public through the SOL Association for Research. His time and efforts are without compensation, and SOL is a non-profit, tax-exempt concern dependent on the commitment of volunteers.

The following is a brief explanation of a Trance, so those without the opportunity to participate have a better understanding of the phenomenon. On the day of a Trance, Mr. LePar remains in a peaceful environment. He consumes little food and The Council recommends his diet include red shellfish. He engages in considerable prayer and meditation throughout the day.

Those participating in a Trance, to question The Council, gather about a half hour before the session for socializing. Nancy LePar, his wife, is always the last to leave her husband before a Trance begins. She sits with him in a separate room as he quiets himself with prayer and meditation. When she enters the room in which the trance is to be conducted, all talking and noise cease. Soon he enters, silent and already in an altered state. With everyone seated and quiet, he enters, removes his slippers and positions himself on the floor.

He wears, as instructed by The Council, loose clothing of all natural fabric. Also, Mr. LePar wears no metal other than a wedding ring and cross. As he rests his head and bare feet on pillows, he maneuvers his body into alignment with magnetic north. Those participating, following instructions from The Council, are to place themselves in a quiet, prayerful state as until this remarkable source begins to speak. There are two distinct time periods in the linking of LePar's spiritual vibrations with those of The Council. The first period concludes with LePar's extremely deep and rapid breathing, a form of [hyperventilation](#). His hands, folded across the abdomen, quiver; his left leg stiffens and his left foot extends. Then, suddenly, silence. It seems almost as if he has stopped breathing. Finally, The Council begins to speak -- slowly at first, repeating the name of the Trance moderator, until the link with the physical world is ready. It usually takes about thirty minutes from the time Mr. LePar lies down until The Council speaks. But on some occasions, for a variety of reasons, it can be as long as 45 minutes.

Once The Council begins to communicate, a Trance usually lasts between ninety minutes and two hours. The Council is offered the opportunity to give the gathering an opening statement, which has always become a segment of information useful for universal spiritual growth. Then, the trances follow a simple question-and-answer format, beginning with written questions and continuing with follow-up questions raised by The Council's comments. At some sessions, there are so many follow-up questions that only the first question asked will be from the list of written questions.

Afterwards, when Mr. LePar awakens, he remembers nothing. His memory is blank from the time his wife leaves him before each session until he awakens at the conclusion of the Trance. He is always physically drained, cold and disoriented. He is helped to a seat, wrapped in an afghan for warmth, and given a slice of bread and a glass of orange juice to help him recover.

We hope you profit from the information in these Trance Library Files. If reading a particular file gives rise to a question, we encourage you to contact us for more information. Thank you.

FOREWORD

The Council has told us on many occasions that truth has always been available to mankind from the very beginning. As you read this Trance Library File, you may note similarities to information from other sources. You will also encounter new information. You may be surprised by some of the information revealed by The Council, to the point where it strains your credulity. The Council realizes this, and so they often begin a Research Group Trance with an opening statement such as this:

Again, a reminder as we have said before, we ask that you think about what we have said, the answers to your questions. It is not necessary to accept everything we say, but we do ask that you take the time to think on what we have said and hold it for possible use or acceptance at a later time. What is most important is that you do think, that you exercise your God-given mind. Use what you can use and store away that which is not serviceable at this time, for if you wish to see a dawn tomorrow with its clear blue skies, you must make ready for it now. If you cannot believe that tomorrow will be a better day than today, then it will not be so for you. If you do not carry the light of tomorrow, then where will it come from? If your tomorrow is not planned for today, then how can it exist? Forearmed with the knowledge of the path you are presently traveling, you are then in a position to create a better path for your travels tomorrow. The outlook for the children of the Divine is definitely a bright and sunny day. Only you can make the decision as to what your tomorrow will be. We have one distinct advantage over each of you, and that is we have gone through the process of life that you are presently experiencing and in those activities we have learned that one must never narrow their vision down to what they prefer to see, but it is great wisdom when one is willing to look at the total picture, even those segments that one wishes were not there.

Always keep this concept in mind: Use what information you can, and that which you cannot agree with, put it aside for now. Do not discard it, for you may find it very useful in the future.

392 have not taken advantage of the opportunities available to you while in the material
393 manifestation, thus you have relegated yourselves to the man-made heavenly realms. The
394 fear comes from a degree of awareness of the conditions in the man-made heavenly realms.

NOTES

(1) **Title** - This is the topic of the Trance Library File.

(2) **Page** - This is the page number of the Trance Library File. Each Trance Library File begins with page one.

(3) **Selection** - This number indicates the chronological order of this block of information in the whole of the Trance material.

(4) **Key Word** - This is the search word used for this selection.

(5) **Date** - This is the date on which the Trance occurred. It is given as a year-month-day (80-06-28).

(6) **Trance Number** - All of Mr. LePar's Trances have been numbered chronologically beginning with number one. This number indicates from which Trance this selection was drawn.

(7) **Master Volume Information** - All information from all Trances is transcribed in chronological order into the SOL Master Volume. This line indicates the page number and line number as found in the Master Volume.

(8) **Line Number** - The transcript of each Trance session is numbered from one. If a Trance Library File is made up of information from more than one Trance, then these numbers will change sequence.

(9) **Questioner** - The symbol *** indicates an individual at the Trance asking a question or responding to The Council's remarks. This is used to maintain confidentiality.

(10) **Council** - The symbol **C:** indicates that The Council is speaking.

101 side of the body.

103 ***: You mean 24 inches, Council?

105 C: 24 inches, yes.

107 ***: Maintaining on the left side of the body. One of us should

108 be up there to help the children, shouldn't we, Council?

109

110 C: That would be reasonable, but they can all be brought up or

111 those who choose can be brought up all together.

113 ***: Children, would you like to come up? Please come up on this

114 side. Now, would anyone like to say something to The Council or

115 question them?

117 C: May we speak to them first?

118

119 ***: Yes.

120

121 C: You realize that Mr. LePar is sleeping, don't you? Or what you

122 understand as sleeping, and he is allowing us to use his sleeping

123 body, similar to a radio or a television. And we can answer your
124 questions and talk to you, just as if you could do that through the
125 radio or the television. Mr. LePar is sleeping, in a sense, but he
126 is not inside of his body, like you are inside of your bodies. Do
127 you understand that?

128

129 Children: Yes.

130

131 C: His soul and his mind have gone far, far away for a short
132 period of time, and they are sitting, his mind and his soul, are
133 sitting out into the heavens, waiting to come back. Now, his body
134 does not hurt, or he does not feel any pain, or he is not afraid
135 because he knows that when we are finished talking with you that he
136 will be able to come back. Do you understand that?

138 Children: Yes.

140 C: So, maybe you could pretend that Mr. LePar is just sleeping and
141 that you can talk to his physical body just as if you were to talk
142 to him. But remember in the back of your mind that he cannot talk
143 to you; we are talking to you, and we go by the name of The
144 Council. Now, we are much like each of you are, only we are grown
145 up as you would understand it. We are even grown up more than your
146 mothers and fathers, and we are some place close to Mr. LePar, some
147 place close. We can see him, and he can see us. Now, we are
148 talking about his soul and his consciousness. Do you understand
149 that?

150

151 Children: Yes.

152

153 C: Oh, we can see his physical body just like you can, but we are

154 really not too interested in that since he has given us permission
155 to use it to talk to you and your mothers and fathers and many, many,
156 many more people. When we get through answering your questions,
157 then we will tell him that we are done, and he will come back to
158 his body and it will be just as if he had never left. Do you
159 understand?

160

161 Children: Yes.

162

163 C: So there is nothing really to worry about or be scared of, is
164 there?

165

166 Children: No.

167

168 C: All right. Now, who wants to be the first to ask us some very
169 important questions, and remember, anything that you can think of to
170 ask us you can, and it is not a stupid question or it is not a dumb
171 question because if it is something you are wondering about, there
172 is an awful lot of other young kids who are wondering about
173 the same thing. And you are not only getting your questions
174 answered but you are going to get those same answers for a whole
175 bunch more of other kids. So, we are ready. Are you ready to ask
176 us your questions?

177

178 Children: Yes.

179

180 C: All right. Let's go.

181

182 ***: What is God's favorite job that people can do?

183

184 C: Well, the most favorite job of God's for people to do is to

185 like themselves and to think good of themselves. Do you understand
186 what we are saying?

187

188 ***: Yes.

189

190 C: You know, an awful lot of people just do not like themselves
191 and that is why they do things that they should not do. God's most
192 important job and most favorite job for other people to do is to like
193 themselves because if they like themselves then they are going to
194 be better people and they are going to be closer to God, and the
195 more they begin to like themselves, then God is going to help them
196 to like themselves even more because they are going to be nicer
197 people and easier to like. Does that answer your question enough?

198

199 ***: Yes.

201 C: Do you want to ask anything else?

202

203 ***: Yes.

204

205 C: Well, ask us.

206

207 ***: Did dragons ever exist?

208

209 C: Oh, yes they did, but, you know, they really did not breathe fire
210 like you see or like you think or like you have been told. They kind
211 of snorted a lot and made terrible noises and they flapped wee little
212 wings that would not take them anyplace, but they really could jump
213 awfully far when they wanted to. And a lot of times people thought
214 that they actually flew just because they could jump so far, but
215 they did not breathe fire and they did not have wings that could

216 fly, that they could fly with. They were too heavy, and they would
217 have had to have had really big, big wings, and their wings really
218 were not that big. Does that answer your question?

219

220 ***: Yes.

222 C: Do you want to know anything else about dragons?

223

224 ***: No.

226 C: Okay.

227

228 ***: Is Atlantis really under the sea?

229

230 C: Oh yes, yes, it is deep down under the sea, and it is there
231 because people were not very nice. If people are better, nicer to
232 each other, then things like that do not happen or at least the
233 people have a chance to get away from those areas that are going to
234 go under water. Does that answer your question?

235

236 ***: Yes.

237

238 C: Very well.

239

240 ***: Do you have feelings like us?

241

242 C: Oh yes, we have a lot of feelings. Most of our feelings are of
243 happiness and we kind of laugh but we do not really laugh because
244 we are a little bit different than what you are because you are in
245 a physical body, but did you ever get really tickled inside or
246 thrilled where you were really super happy?

247

248 ***: Yes.

249

250 C: Well, that is the way we are all the time. We never get sad,
251 and we never cry, and we never have a hard time. It is always a
252 joyful experience. It is full of fun. Our fun is not always like
253 your fun, but we have fun too. Does that answer your question?

255 ***: Yes.

256

257 C: Do you have any more?

258

259 ***: Yes.

260

261 C: Well, go on. Ask them.

262

263 ***: Who made God?

264

265 C: Well, that is really a very hard question to answer because you
266 and your parents cannot really think big enough. Do you understand
267 what we mean by that?

268

269 ***: No.

270

271 C: It is almost like not being smart enough to understand words.
272 Do you understand that now?

273

274 ***: Yes.

275

276 C: But we will try to tell you. Long, long, long time ago, you
277 could say, now we are kind of telling you a story so that you

278 understand something. Do you understand what we are going to do?

279

280 ***: Yes.

281

282 C: Long, long time ago God was kind of like a baby, not that He
283 was small, but He did not do an awful lot. He kind of came into a
284 situation. The only thing that we can tell you before that was
285 that God always was, but up to a point we can tell you how God came
286 to be what He is today. There are certain things that we cannot
287 understand about God until we are right with Him, inside of Him,
288 and living with Him. Right now, we are just a little bit outside
289 of Him, so we cannot tell you if He did have a beginning, but what
290 we know now is this, that God, long, long, long, long time ago, was
291 like a little baby, much like the little baby in this room. And
292 one day God grew up, and all of a sudden, He realized how happy He
293 was. But He looked around, and He had all this happiness, but
294 there was not anybody else. So, God decided, since He was God and
295 He was so happy, He was going to make somebody else. So He did.
296 He made Christ. From there He and Christ sat down one day and
297 said, "We have all this happiness and all this joy, but what about
298 sharing it so we could be happier and have more joy." And so God
299 gave Christ permission to create all of you and all of your
300 parents. When God was a little baby, He was a lot like a rocket or
301 a firework. Do you know how those are? They kind of shoot up in
302 the air and all of a sudden they burst into beautiful colors and
303 sparkly stuff. Well, when God was like a baby, that was Him flying
304 up higher and higher into the sky or into the heavens, and all of a
305 sudden when He grew up it was just like a fireworks going off. He
306 realized how beautiful He was and how happy He was, and He just
307 could not keep it all to Himself. So He started Creation from that
308 point. Does that answer your question?

309

310 ***: Yes.

312 C: When we get with God completely, when we are sitting right

313 beside Him and He has his arms around us and He tells us how He was

314 born, if He was born, then we will be happy to tell you. But by

315 that time, you are going to be here with us too, so maybe God will

316 allow us to whisper that little thing in your ear, maybe. Does

317 that answer your question?

318

319 ***: Yes.

320

321 C: Do you have any more?

322

323 ***: No.

324

325 C: Well, maybe you can think of some more.

326

327 ***: What is the smartest animal?

328

329 C: Speak up.

330

331 ***: What is the smartest animal?

332

333 C: Well, on earth today there is one that is real smart, and that

334 is the dolphin. The second smartest is a humpback whale. Those

335 are the two smartest. Does that answer your question?

336

337 ***: Yes.

338

339 C: Do you have any more?

340

341 ***: How did Mary get pregnant?

342

343 C: Oh, that is a very hard question to answer, but we will try to
344 answer it as simply as we can so you will be able to understand it.
345 You see, Mary was a very, very special woman, just like your
346 mothers are, only she never came to earth before. She came to
347 earth only once. Now, we understand or we know that you do not
348 understand that very well, but as you get older you will know what
349 we are talking about. And God had a very special love for her
350 because she was so good, and God sent an angel to ask her if she
351 would like to be the mother of God or the mother of Christ, and she
352 said yes. Well, then God sent an angel to Joseph, that was Mary's
353 husband, to see if it was all right with him, and he said sure. So
354 God sent a shaft of light down into Mary, and Jesus traveled that
355 shaft of light into Mary. Does that answer your question?

356

357 ***: Yes.

358

359 C: It was almost like a sliding board of light, and He, just as a
360 baby, slid down right down to her, and she took care of Him from
361 that moment on. Does that answer your question?

362

363 ***: Yes.

364

365 C: All right.

366

367 ***: How did heaven get made?

368

369 C: Oh, well that is an easy question to answer. You see, long,
370 long, long, long time ago there was no heaven like you understand

371 heaven. Everybody was with God, and that was heaven. But then
372 some people just did not pay attention to God, and they started not
373 to like themselves very much, and so they did things that kind of made
374 them move away from God, and they kept moving away and kept moving
375 away until finally they came to earth. But when they were in heaven,
376 everything was full of fun; everything was happiness. It was
377 like always singing or always dancing or always eating your
378 favorite ice cream or always watching your favorite television show
379 or always playing with your most favorite toy or playing with your
380 most favorite friend. Does that answer your question?

381

382 ***: Yes.

383

384 C: The heaven that most people know about today, it is heaven but
385 it is not just like it was when God made it. So they kind of go to
386 a first-grade heaven or a second-grade heaven, where it is a lot of
387 fun, but it is not as much fun as when you graduate from that
388 heaven. Do you understand that?

389

390 ***: Yes.

391

392 C: So, when you leave your body, you are going to go to heaven,
393 but you still have to go through that first heaven and that second
394 heaven. You kind of have to learn some things that you did not
395 learn now. Then you go to God's heaven. Do you understand that?

396

397 ***: Yes.

398

399 C: It is a lot more fun in God's heaven, but it is kind of fun in
400 the other heavens, too. It is like only being allowed to have ice
401 cream once a week, and then when you get into God's heaven, you can

402 have it every day and as much as you want, and you never have to
403 worry about getting sick either. Does that answer your question?

404

405 ***: Yes.

406

407 C: Are you sure?

408

409 ***: Yes.

410

411 C: Okay.

412

413 ***: How did the dinosaurs die?

414

415 C: Oh, that is another hard question for you to understand. You
416 know, a long time ago when there was a lot of them, men used to
417 hunt them, just like they hunt animals today, and they did an awful
418 lot of hunting at that time because it was kind of like a game.
419 You know how some people hunt and make trophies of the animals'
420 heads?

421

422 ***: Yes.

423

424 C: Well, that was kind of a sporting thing that they used to do
425 with the dinosaurs, but they got to the point where there was not a
426 whole lot of them, and then there was terrible earthquakes and land
427 started moving, and most of them got killed off at that time. And
428 those that remained, well, men kind of hunted them to eat what they
429 could eat out of them. Do you understand?

430

431 ***: Yes.

432

433 C: There was not a whole lot of the dinosaur that they could eat,
434 even though it was big, but some of the meat was not very good to
435 eat or didn't taste very good, so that meant they had to kill more.
436 One dinosaur didn't feed an awful lot of people for very long.

437 Does that answer your question?

438

439 ***: Yes.

440

441 C: All right.

442

443 ***: What happens after we die?

444

445 C: Well, you don't really know that you die. You have to almost
446 be told that you are dead. You just kind of all of a sudden find
447 yourself out of your body. Do you understand what we are saying?

448

449 ***: Yes.

450

451 C: You can look at yourself, and you can look at everybody around
452 you, and you don't even know that you are dead. You don't feel any
453 different because when you die, you don't change, you don't feel
454 anything, and then when you decide to leave there then you go and you
455 stand before Christ and you talk with Him or maybe you might talk
456 with your grandmother or grandfather or an uncle or an aunt who
457 died before you. And they are there waiting for you and they greet
458 you and they give you kisses and hugs and all that stuff and then
459 after you talk to them for awhile, then you get to talk with Christ,
460 and He becomes your friend then. Does that answer your question?

461

462 ***: Yes.

463

464 C: Is there anything else you want to know?

465

466 ***: No.

467

468 C: All right.

469

470 ***: Are soldiers still around these days?

471

472 C: "Are soldiers still around?"

473

474 ***: Yes.

475

476 C: Well, what kind of soldiers are you asking about?

477

478 ***: Soldiers that fight people.

479

480 C: Well, it saddens us to say that yes there are still some

481 soldiers around that fight people and hurt people, but maybe

482 someday there won't be any soldiers to hurt other people. Maybe

483 someday everybody will be nice to each other and be happy with each

484 other. What do you think?

485

486 ***: I don't know.

487

488 C: Very well. Does that answer your question?

489

490 ***: No.

491

492 C: Well, what else would you like to know about soldiers?

493

494 ***: Did they slay dragons?

495

496 C: Well, long time ago when there was dragons, yes, they used to
497 fight dragons, but it took an awful lot of them to fight one dragon
498 because sometimes dragons were pretty big and they were covered
499 with pretty hard scales or kind of things that looked like plates
500 of metal but they weren't metal, they were just thick things like
501 your fingernails, and sometimes it took a lot of soldiers to get
502 rid of a dragon. Does that answer your question?

503

504 ***: Yes.

505

506 C: Okay.

507

508 ***: How did deers get invented?

509

510 C: How did what get invented?

511

512 ***: Deers.

513

514 C: Deers. Well, they just kind of started out as really small
515 little animals, and they just kind of kept growing over a long
516 period of time till they were deers. Does that answer your
517 question?

518

519 ***: Yes.

520

521 C: Very well.

522

523 ***: Were Adam and Eve really made from dirt?

524

525 C: Well, you could say that but it would be kind of a simple way

526 of saying it. They weren't really made from dirt, but they were
527 made from elements of the earth, and did you ever see a magnet pull
528 a bunch of little metal chips around it?

529

530 ***: Yes.

531

532 C: Well, you could say that Adam and Eve, their soul, when they
533 came near the earth kind of pulled a bunch of stuff towards it and
534 it kind of made their body then, and these things that had pulled
535 towards them were the elements of nature, but God really didn't
536 pick up some mud and make a body like the story tells you. What
537 the story tries to tell you is that you are part of this earth and
538 that you have to do the best job living that you can, so that you
539 don't have to be around here forever and ever and ever. Do you
540 understand what we are saying?

541

542 ***: Yes.

543

544 C: Does that answer your question enough?

545

546 ***: Yes.

547

548 C: Okay

549

550 ***: Is there really a dinosaur-like creature that lives in Loch

551 Ness?

552

553 C: Yes, there is really. The problem is they don't realize there
554 are subterranean channels that connect that particular body of
555 water with other bodies of water, not only that but there are
556 underground lakes that this particular animal is able to go to or

557 escape to. Does that answer your question?

558

559 ***: Yes.

560

561 C: It is real.

562

563 ***: What is it like to be in heaven?

564

565 C: Well, it is a lot of fun, really. There are things we get to

566 do here that you can't do now, and when you get here you will be

567 able to do those things too. We can talk to people without ever

568 moving our lips, and we can know everything there is to know, and

569 we get to see God, and we get to move to places that we never could

570 move to when we were on earth. Does that answer your question?

571

572 ***: Yes.

573

574 C: It is like having fun all the time, having whatever you wanted

575 all the time. The best thing that you can think of, the most fun

576 thing you can think of, that is what heaven is like, and there are

577 no secrets, there is no one that is mean. Everybody is nice.

578 Everybody likes each other. Everybody loves each other. Everybody

579 helps everybody. It's just a nice place to be, really. Does that

580 answer your question enough?

581

582 ***: Yes. How did cardboard get invented?

583

584 C: Well, that's one thing we really don't know the answer to, so

585 maybe you ought to ask your daddy. He is pretty smart too, you

586 know.

587

588 ***: How did babies get in stomachs?

589

590 C: Well, that's really something you should ask your mommy and

591 daddy about, but it is kind of like a miracle when it happens. It

592 is kind of like a magnet pulling something very beautiful to it.

593 Do you know what a magnet is?

594

595 ***: Yes.

596

597 C: Well, it is something like that. But for other questions, you

598 really should ask your mommy and daddy about that. All right?

599

600 ***: How were stars made?

601

602 C: Well, a long time ago, an awful long time ago, there was kind

603 of like a big star or there were a lot of big stars, and they just

604 got too big and too heavy, so they kind of exploded, and all the

605 pieces went flying out into the sky, and when they got far enough

606 away, they just kind of slowed up and kind of started spinning around

607 and kind of slowed up even more and then they kind of grew brighter

608 and brighter as they burnt up, and they threw off little pieces of

609 stone and what have you, and those were the planets. Does that answer

610 your question?

611

612 ***: Yes.

613

614 C: Now, when we say "little," we are not talking about teeny,

615 teeny little, but we are talking about great big little. Stones as

616 big as the earth. So you know the first star had to be awfully,

617 awfully, awfully big. You understand that, don't you?

618

619 ***: Yes.

620

621 C: All right. Very well.

622

623 ***: Why does Bill do Trances?

624

625 C: Well, you know, a long time ago and this was before he was born,
626 he was in heaven just like each of you were in heaven before you were
627 born, and a very special, special person in heaven asked him if he
628 wouldn't do these so that people on earth could learn a lot more
629 about God, and he said that he would. And so when he was born
630 then, even when he was a wee little baby and then a little kid like
631 all of you are, he knew deep down inside of him that he was going
632 to do something but he didn't know what it was, and as he grew up,
633 then he began to learn what it was that he was going to do, and
634 finally when he had learned an awful lot about life and he learned
635 how to be a nice person, then he started doing these things. Does
636 that answer your question?

637

638 ***: Yes.

639

640 C: All right. And he will be doing them for awhile longer yet,
641 and then when he doesn't have to do them anymore, maybe he will
642 have a little rest period and then he will go back to God.

643

644 ***: Do the Trances hurt Bill?

645

646 C: Oh, sometimes they make him tired and wear him out, but there
647 is no physical pain. Does that answer your question?

648

649 ***: Yes.

650

651 C: Actually, it kind of makes him feel good after the tiredness
652 goes away because he knows that he has done something good for
653 people. When he is sleeping like this, it is a lot of fun for him
654 because he gets to talk to a lot of people in heaven, a lot of
655 people that he used to know, and he is always meeting new friends
656 while he is up there, but, see, when he comes back to his body, he
657 can't remember anything like that though. Does that answer your
658 question?

659

660 ***: Yes.

661

662 C: All right.

663

664 ***: How did other people talk different languages?

665

666 C: Oh, there was kind of a lot of people all over the earth and
667 they just started making sounds that everybody agreed upon was
668 language and then when they started to get more and more people where
669 they could start traveling and meet other people, then all the
670 different other people that were gathered together, they decided on
671 different sounds from what the other people did. Do you
672 understand?

673

674 ***: Yes.

675

676 C: Well, that is how come you have different languages, and nobody
677 has ever been smart enough to decide that maybe it would be easier
678 if everybody spoke the same language. But that would save a lot of
679 problems in the world today if everybody could speak the same
680 language. It is just over the period of time they kept making

681 noises and said that each noise meant something. That is how
682 different languages started. Does that answer your question?

683

684 ***: Yes.

685

686 C: All right.

687

688 ***: How did cloth get invented?

689

690 C: "How did cloth get invented." Well, that is another one of
691 those questions that we are not sure of what the answer is, so
692 maybe you could ask your mommy and daddy that. But we think that
693 maybe, just maybe, someone found some awfully big leaves and
694 started wearing the leaves, and when they found out that when the
695 leaves died that there were strings and stuff in them, so they
696 started drying the leaves first and taking the strings and tying
697 them together and then kept tying more and more strings together
698 until they had something that looked like a piece of cloth. Does
699 that answer your question?

700

701 ***: Yes.

702

703 C: All right.

704

705 ***: Does the room Bill's in when he is doing a Trance affect him
706 afterwards?

707

708 C: No, the room doesn't affect him afterwards, but the room itself
709 is affected in a positive way or in a good way. Some people who
710 are very sensitive can usually feel something different about the
711 rooms where the Trances were done in, particularly if there has been

712 more than one Trance in that room. But you have to be kind of
713 sensitive to really notice that difference and to be that sensitive
714 you have to kind of be a good person, because if you are not a good
715 person you cannot feel that change in the room. Does that answer
716 your question?

717

718 ***: Yes.

719

720 ***: How does metal get made?

721

722 C: Well, again that is something that you should ask your daddy,
723 but we will try to tell you a little bit about that. They kind of dig
724 up dirt and heat it up, but it is kind of a special dirt, and when
725 they heat it enough, it kind of gets like water, and they pour it
726 out in some kind of shape and then when it cools it gets hard.
727 Does that answer your question?

728

729 ***: Yes.

730

731 C: Okay.

732

733 ***: Well, Council, it seems that the children have run out of
734 questions.

735

736 C: Now, if you remember, didn't Mr. LePar ask you all to ask one
737 question for him?

738

739 Children: Yes.

740

741 C: Maybe some of you would like to ask a question for Mr. LePar.
742 (Pause) Well, if you cannot think of a question to ask this time,

743 maybe in the future we will get a chance to talk to all of you
744 again, and while we have the opportunity we would like to thank you
745 for allowing us to talk to you, and we hope that maybe someday in the
746 future you would let us talk to you again. Maybe you would like to
747 talk to us again in the future. So we thank you very much for
748 letting us talk to you. All right?

749

750 Children: All right.

751

752 C: Thank you.

753

754 ***: What would you like at this time, Council, we are about 50

755 minutes into the Trance?

756

1023 C: We would like to say a closing word to the children. We would
1024 like to thank you very much for asking us questions. Thank you
1025 because we enjoy talking to you and thank you because you have
1026 asked some questions that a lot of other young people would like to
1027 know the answers to, and now that you have asked them, someday
1028 those young people will have the opportunity to find out the answers
1029 to those questions. We only hope that we have the opportunity to
1030 speak with all of you again, and maybe the next time you won't be
1031 so nervous or feel so funny about talking to us. We are just like
1032 you are. We are more like you are than we are your parents, and
1033 you can talk to us in ways that you can't talk to your mom and dad,
1034 so we are kind of like good friends to you. You can ask us things
1035 that you might not want to ask your mom and dad, and those things
1036 that are especially proper or right for your moms and dads to answer
1037 you about we'll suggest that you talk to them. There are certain

1038 things that your mommies and daddies should talk to you about and

1039 not us. But again, we thank you for that opportunity. Very well.

1040 Are there any other questions?

1041

1042 ***: Are there people living on other planets?

1043

1044 C: Oh yes, there are a lot of different kind of people living on

1045 other planets. Not all of them look like you do, and some of them

1046 don't even have bodies. They are just them. They are what we call

1047 conscious state beings. You can't see them; you can't touch them;

1048 but they are every bit as real as you are. Does that answer your

1049 question?

1050

1051 ***: Yes.

1052

1053 C: All right.

1054

1055 ***: Is there a tenth planet in our solar system?

1056

1057 C: Well, that depends on what you constitute as a planet. There

1058 are bodies out there that have not yet been fully discovered, so as

1059 to say to you, yes, there is a tenth or an eleventh or a twelfth,

1060 or a thirteenth planet, that is a subjective statement. There are

1061 definitely large bodies that could be considered planets, although

1062 they would be somewhat smaller. Does that answer your question?

1063

1064 ***: Yes.

1065

1066 C: Very well. Again, we thank you for this opportunity, and we

1067 appreciate your time and your questions. Are there any last

1068 questions dealing with business?

1069

1070 ***: When Bill was walking in the door, what was that white thing?

1071

1072 C: What white thing are you talking about?

1073

1074 ***: The thing that was hanging on him.

1075

1076 C: Oh, you see, some of your mommies and daddies have done a very

1077 good job helping us to talk to a lot of people, and so we kind of

1078 are going to give them a gift to show them how much we appreciate

1079 what they have done to help. So, we are kind of making that gift

1080 as it hangs around Mr. LePar's neck. Do you understand?

1081

1082 ***: Yes.

1083

1084 C: All right.

1085

1086 ***: There are no further questions, Council.

1087

1088 C: Very well. May those Blessings that we have received from our

1089 Divine Father, from our Lord and Saviour, may they be accepted by

1090 each and every one of us. May they be accepted by your friends

1091 and your immediate family. May those gifts that we have been given

1092 be accepted by each and every one of you. We thank you very much.

1093

1094 All: Thank you.
